A meeting of residents of Katoomba Falls Creek Valley was held on November 19th, 1989. The purposes of that meeting were;

- + an opportunity for residents of the valley to share in protecting the environment of the valley, especially public lands
  - + sharing information about the public lands
  - + sharing ideas about the best uses of Frank Walford Park and other public lands, for residents and also for visitors
  - + discuss current uses of Frank Walford Park and other public lands and the concerns of residents
  - + decide on goals for the public lands in the Katoomba Falls Creek valley and how to achieve these goals.
- Six hundred residents of the Valley were invited. The meeting was attended by forty people and fifteen people sent their apologies.

One of the outcomes of that meeting was a decision to hold a public meeting on Sunday, December 10, 1989 at 2.00 p.m. at the Civic Centre in Katoomba Street. The purpose of that meeting is to launch a campaign for the protection of Katoomba Falls Creek Valley. A press release and notice of the meeting will be in the Gazette in the next couple of weeks.

We are a group of people who were chosen to organise that public meeting and we have been authorised by the residents who met on November 19th to invite you, as our local Council representative to that meeting.
