Position on motor vehicle racing in Frank Walford Park

The meeting agreed to the following position on motor vehicle racing in Frank Walford Park:

- there shall be no motor vehicle (cars, motor bikes, go-carts) racing, lap dashes, or time trials in Frank Walford Park
- there shall be only authorised use by motor vehicles of the roadway in Frank Walford Park - Council to be requested to close off all unauthorised access points
- pedestrians and bicyclists shall have access to the roadway at all times - Council to be requested to provide gate access for cyclists and pedestrians behind the ornamental lake
- Council to be requested to advertise in the Communicator in the Gazette those motor vehicle events which are already arranged for 1990.

The meeting agreed to write to Council now, setting out the group's agreed position on motor vehicle racing in Frank Walford Park.
