#### **Amendments to Constitution:**

1. New clause added to "Interpretation – Rule1" as point 2:

**Upper Kedumba River Valley is approximately bordered in the north by Bathurst Rd; in the east by Katoomba St; in the South by Birdwood Ave, Cliff Dr. , Cedar St and the escarpment area that abuts Jamison Valley, including Katoomba Falls and in the west by Cliff Dr., Narrow Neck Rd and Valley Rd. The upper Kedumba River Valley is all the land and creeks that lie within the water catchment of the Upper Kedumba River.**

2 "Objects – Rule 1B point #6 becomes:

**To ensure the uses of the lands within the Upper Kedumba River Valley conform to the zonings within LEP 2005 and LEP 1991 and the categories within the Upper Kedumba River Valley Plans of Management( April 2004 )**

3 "Objects – Rule 1B point #9 " change to:

**To ensure the rehabilitation of scoured, eroded and damaged areas of the Upper Kedumba River Valley, especially in the Frank Walford Park, Mcrae's Paddock, Katoomba Falls Reserve and Selby St Reserve and in the middle sections of the valley, especially the swamps, with special attention to elimination of weeds and plant and animal pests and to promote endemic revegetation.**
